

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

On behalf of the Peoria Fire Department, sealed bids will be received in the Office of the Ottawa County Clerk, Reba G. Sill, at 102 East Central Avenue, Suite 103 in Miami, Oklahoma 74354, until 9:05 AM on November 3, 2014. Bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud by the Board of County Commissioners on the following:

Lease/purchase option shall be exercised in accordance with O.S. 62, Section 430.1. Vendor must secure financing with a competitive interest rate not to exceed that allowed by statute.

Bids received late will be returned unopened.

Based upon the recommendation of the Peoria Fire Department, the Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any or all bids and/or make an award to other than the low bidder, if such an award is deemed to be in the best interest of the County.
