The flood insurance rate maps (FIRM) and other flood data used by the County Flood Plain Administrator and/or Board in evaluating flood hazards to proposed developments are considered reasonable and accurate for regulatory purposes and are based on the best available scientific and engineering data. On rare occasions greater floods can and will occur and flood heights may be increased by manmade or natural causes. Issuance of a development permit, demolition permit, or variance does not imply that developments inside or outside the identified areas of special flood hazard will be protected from flooding or flood damage. Issuance of a development permit, demolition permit, or variance shall not create liability on the part of Ottawa County, the County Flood Plain Administrator, the Ottawa County Flood Plain Board, or any officer or employee of Ottawa County (hereinafter collectively called "County") in the event flooding or flood damage does occur. Therefore, the undersigned do(es), for his/her/their own part and on behalf of his/her/their successors and assigns, and/or heirs, executors and administrators, or employees hereby remise, release and forever discharge County of and from any and all manner of, actions and causes of action, rights, suits, judgements, claims and demands whatsoever in law or equity, including claims for contribution, arising from and by reason of any and all KNOWN AND UNKNOWN, FORESEEN AND UNFORESEEN bodily and personal injuries or death, damage to property, and the consequences thereof, which hereafter may be sustained by the undersigned or by any and all other persons, associations and corporations, whether herein named or referred to or not, from all liability arising from the issuance of a development permit, demolition permit, or variance.
