The Ottawa County Board of Commissioners held their regularly scheduled meeting at 9:00 AM with the following members present: John Clarke, Chairman, Russell Earls and Gary Wyrick. First Assistant District Attorney Ben Loring was also in attendance.

Notice of the meeting was posted at the south door of the Ottawa County Courthouse at 3:48 PM on June 7, 2012. Commissioners' Meeting Agendas and Minutes can also be found online at ottawa.okcounties.org.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Sara Beckwith, a resident of M Street Southwest, came before the Board to voice her opposition to a proposed housing development at the corner of 20th Avenue Southwest and M Street Southwest in Miami, Oklahoma. Beckwith fears this new income-based development will diminish the value of her property. While the Commissioners understand her concerns, they informed Beckwith that they must consider the housing needs of the entire County and – because Ottawa County has no Planning or Zoning Regulations – the Board does not have the authority to stop the development.
