

PROGRAMMING RESOLUTION 2015-14

Be it remembered that on 2nd day of June, 2015, at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Ottawa County, the following resolution was presented, read, and adopted:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the following type of improvement project has been selected for consideration: Only one (1) selection is to be made per resolution:

"STP" Project

Federal Surface Transportation Program

Funded with a Combination of Federal and Other Funds (CIRB)

"CIRB" Project

County Improvements for Roads and Bridges

Funded with 100% County Improvements for Roads and Bridges (285C) Funds

WHEREAS, The following types of funding are requested to be applied to the project as follows:

Match Federal BR or STP Funds with CIRB Funds Funds from County

Pay Engineering Contract fees with CIRB Funds Funds from County

Pay Right-of-way clearance costs with CIRB Funds Funds from County

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Ottawa County has selected a construction project in District 2 as follows:

Bridge 105 (NBI 06603), which spans a tributary to Brush Creek is a 25 ft. I-beam span with a concrete deck. This bridge was originally constructed in 1939. The deck, superstructure, and substructure are rated fair, fair, and serious respectively. The structure has a sufficiency rating of 37.9. This bridge has an operating load rating of 5.7 tons. The low water crossing at Brush creek is overtopped frequently and with the increase in traffic along the roadway it is becoming unsafe for the traveling public.

WHEREAS, the Engineer's preliminary estimate of project cost is:
\$ 2,830,000.

WHEREAS, the County has selected the following to perform design engineering services in the preparation of detailed plans, specifications and estimates for this project:

WHEREAS, the County agrees that projects shall be selected by the individual Boards of County Commissioners who shall consider the total County-wide improvement needs.

WHEREAS, the County's Five Year Road and Bridge Plan has been amended to include this project in federal fiscal year 2022.

WHEREAS, the County agrees to provide for satisfactory maintenance after completion of the project, and to furnish the necessary right-of-way clear and unobstructed. Maintenance inspections of completed projects shall be conducted periodically by the Department, and maintenance inspection reports noting any deficiencies shall be forwarded to the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners. Such deficiencies in maintenance shall be corrected by said County prior to any continuation of funding to said County under the County Improvements for Roads and Bridges or Federal-aid BR or STP Programs.

WHEREAS, the County agrees that as a condition to receiving any federal financial assistance from the Department of Transportation, it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42, U.S.C. 2000d-et seq., and all requirements imposed by or pursuant to Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, "Nondiscrimination of Federally-Assisted Programs of the Department of Transportation-Effectuation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964@, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that if:

- a) a BR or STP project is selected, the Transportation Commission is hereby requested to approve this project for construction and submit same to the Federal Highway Administration for approval.
- b) a CIRB project is selected, the Transportation Commission is hereby requested to approve this project for construction.
