WHEREAS, on March 14, 2020, the President of the United States of America, has declared a national health emergency in the United States as a result of the national spread of COVID-19.

WHEREAS, immediate attention is required to protect public health, ensure public safety, and render emergency relief; and




WHEREAS, the Ottawa County Board of Commissioners finds that the aforementioned conditions constitute a threat to the safety and welfare of the County and create an emergency disaster situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ottawa County Board of Commissioners hereby declares the County of Ottawa to be in a Declared State of Emergency-entitled to aid, relief and assistance- and direct the implementation of the Ottawa County Emergency Operations Plan.


